

PRIVACY POLICY

Modern Resources Inc. (the "**Company**") is committed to protecting your privacy. We use the information we collect about you to facilitate the provision of our services and to provide you with a more personalized experience. We have created this Privacy Policy in order to demonstrate our firm commitment to protecting the privacy of all of our clients and service providers.

We are also careful to ensure that information is used responsibly, and only for the purposes for which it is provided.

This Privacy Policy is intended to comply with the federal government's privacy legislation, the *Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act*, as well as Alberta's *Personal Information Protection Act*. We want you to understand how and under what circumstances your personal information is collected, used and disclosed, as well as what The Company is doing to ensure that your information is used according to good business practices and is protected accordingly.

What is Personal Information?

Personal information is information that identifies you as an individual. It includes information such as your name, address, telephone number, birth date, social insurance number, e-mail address and financial information.

The information we may collect or obtain (depending on the circumstances) includes but may not be limited to:

- identification and contact information: such as your name, mailing address, telephone number and personal email address; and
- business relationship and operations information: such as customer and supplier names, customer addresses and personal contacts, credit information, billing records, service and equipment records, any recorded customer complaints, investor contact information and requests, agreement terms and preferences.

Personal Information Collection and Use by the Company

The Company does not collect personal information, except where you provide such information in the course of using the Company's website [http://www. http://www.modernresources.ca](http://www.modernresources.ca) (the "**Website**"). If you provide such information to the Company, we will collect your personal information in order to contact you, to understand your needs and preferences, to better provide our services and to meet statutory or legal obligations. In all circumstances we try to limit our collection of personal information to only those items that are necessary in order for us to provide the best service to our customers.

The Company does not collect personal information about you without your knowledge and consent.

Personal Information Disclosure by the Company

We will not disclose your personal information to third parties without your consent to do so. The Company reserves the right to disclose personal information if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is reasonably necessary to comply with legal process, respond to claims or to protect the rights, property or safety of the Company, its customers, service providers or the public.

When Do We Share Your Personal Information

There are some circumstances where we may share some personal information about our users with a third party. For example:

1. your personal information may be disclosed to a company or individual employed by the Company to perform functions on our behalf such as data processing or document retention. Any such disclosure of your personal information is made on a strictly confidential basis, and the information is to be used only for the purpose for which it was shared. The Company ensures that the company or individual adheres to this Privacy Policy; or
2. subject to applicable regulations, we may disclose your personal information to a government agency, court, or law enforcement personnel.

It is the Company's policy NOT to sell personal information to any third party.

NOTE: Modern has engaged Cortex Business Solutions Inc. ("**Cortex**") as its electronic invoicing processor. Cortex collects the data and personal information you submit when conducting business on our websites and on Cortex's website, such as submitting invoices. Cortex does not sell any personal information that it collects. Cortex may transfer your personal information across provincial or national borders, including to its service providers located in the United States and other jurisdictions outside of Canada who may be subject to applicable disclosure laws in those jurisdictions. By submitting your personal information on our Website and/or Cortex's website, you consent to such transfer and storage. We recognize our obligations to protect personal information. We have therefore made arrangements to secure against the unauthorized access, collection, use, disclosure, copying, modification and disposal of personal information.

The Company considers personal information provided by you to be private and confidential and accordingly we treat it with care.

Consent to Use of Personal Information

By submitting personal information to the Company, you acknowledge and agree that you have consented to the collection, use and disclosure practices set out in this Privacy Policy as they relate to your personal information. You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting the Company's privacy officer as set out below.

Accessing, Correcting or Updating Your Personal Information

At any time, you may request that we correct or update your personal information by contacting the Company's privacy officer as set out below. The Company will use reasonable efforts to ensure that your personal information is accurate and current.
